Dear owners and managers of VF Grace,

I write to you on behalf of the Yukon-Kuskokwim Delta Subsistence Regional Advisory Council (Council). The Council represents subsistence harvesters of fish and wildlife resources on Federal public lands and waters in Yukon-Kuskokwim Delta Region in Western Alaska. The Council was established by the authority in Title VIII of the Alaska National Interest Lands Conservation Act (ANILCA) and is chartered under the Federal Advisory Committee Act. Section 805 of ANILCA and the Council's charter establishes the Council's authority to initiate, review and evaluate proposals for regulations, policies, management plans, and other matters related to subsistence uses of fish and wildlife within the region.

During our public meeting held October 10-12, 2023, in Anchorage, Alaska, the Yukon Delta National Wildlife Refuge and the Association of Village Council Presidents (AVCP) reported to the Council on the negative effects of lead shot to the health of waterfowl, the environment, and people. They also informed us of your company's recent commitment to discontinue selling lead shot to stores throughout the Unit 18 Yukon-Kuskokwim Delta region.

Our Council fully supports this decision and extends our sincere gratitude to your company for making this choice. Eliminating the distribution and subsequent sale of lead shot will help ensure the health of our subsistence resources and the people of our region who depend on them. We hope that you remain committed to this decision even when there are ammunition shortages.

Our Council will continue supporting efforts by the Yukon Delta National Wildlife Refuge and AVCP's Waterfowl Conservation Committee to educate regional residents of the harmful effects of lead shot. We appreciate your willingness to join in this effort to support healthy communities and subsistence resources by ceasing distribution of lead shot.
