

## REGIONAL HUBS

### Meeting Locations for Regional Advisory Councils

For our purpose, a hub is a community that requires only one leg of the trip from the point of origin to the hub community. It may be that not all travelers will live within one leg of the journey to a hub community, but hub communities should meet that requirement for the majority of travelers.

Meeting locations should also provide adequate multiple venue and lodging availability and food options for travelers without stressing the resources of the community.

This list was approved by the ARD on 8/30/23. Councils that need to meet in a community not encompassed by this list must submit a justification for the alternate none-hub location along with a cost comparison.
