I seek the official Federal Hierarchy of the U.S. Department of the Interior (DOI), in its full organizational detail, at all levels, as maintained or managed by the DOI's designated Federal Hierarchy Administrator. As described on https://sam.gov/content/hierarchy , "The Federal Hierarchy is the directory or family tree that establishes relationships between each department's or independent agency's sub-tiers and its offices. It is used by federal agencies as the authoritative source for managing and referencing federal funding and awarding organizations." In the plainest terms, I seek clarity into the entire organizational structure of the DOI from top to bottom, with the exception of its law enforcement capabilities, if the DOI determines that such law enforcement information qualifies for a FOIA exemption. Please note that responsive records that capture only the top few layers in the DOI's federal hierarchy (which are already available on the DOI website) shall not constitute a satisfactory response to this FOIA request.
