DOI OPERATIONAL PROCEDURES MEMORANDUM (OPM) - 36

Subject: Interagency Fire Standards for DOI Pilots

Effective Date: January 1, 2025 Last Updated: January 1, 2015

Expiration Date: December 31, 2025

1. <u>Summary of Changes.</u> The Executive Aviation Subcommittee (EAS) reviewed on 10 November, 2022, and determined that no changes were required to the OPM.

- **2.** <u>Purpose.</u> This OPM establishes policy for the use of DOI pilots on Interagency Fire incidents.
- **3.** <u>Authority.</u> This policy is established by the Director, Department of the Interior, Office of Aviation Services (OAS) in accordance with the provisions of Departmental Manual 112 DM 12, 350 DM 1; and Secretarial Order 3322 dated August 23, 2012.
- **4. Policy.** DOI pilots supporting interagency fire incidents shall:
 - A. Be authorized by their respective bureau to provide such support.
 - B. Meet the pilot qualification requirements of 351 DM 3.3 Vendor Pilot Qualifications.
 - C. Incidental Pilots must also have a Letter of Authorization (see 351 DM 3.2B) issued by at least the regional/state office in coordination with the bureau's national aviation manager. The letter must include a description of pilot duties and restrictions to include any special-use requirements.
 - D. Comply with all requirements of 351 DM 3.1, 351 DM 3.4, 351 DM 3.5 and any other portions of the *Departmental Manual* applicable to DOI pilots, including pilot carding for authorized missions.
