Justification

This proposal requests the Federal Subsistence Board lengthen the caribou season for Federally qualified subsistence users in Unit 9D. This hunt is for the Southern Alaska Peninsula Caribou herd (SAP). The Alaska Board of Game extended the State caribou season in Unit 9D to October 21 via adoption of Proposal 7 at their January 2025 meeting, effective July 1, 2025. This proposed change would maintain alignment of State and Federal seasons.
