

Draft Wildlife Closure Review
WCR26-18

ISSUE: Wildlife Closure Review WCR26-18 is a standard review of a Federal subsistence wildlife closure to sheep hunting by non-federally qualified users in Unit 23, south of Rabbit Creek, Kiyak Creek, and the Noatak River, and west of the Cutler and Redstone Rivers (Baird Mountains) (**Map 1**). It is the Federal Subsistence Board's (Board) policy that Federal public lands should be reopened when a closure is no longer necessary, and that closures will be reviewed at least once every four years. The purpose of this review is to determine if this closure is still warranted.

Closure Location and Species: Unit 23 (Baird Mountains)– Sheep
