**1: What regulation do you wish to change?**

Brown Bear Hunting in Unit 22 seasons and bag limits.

**2: How would the new regulation read?**

22A South of and including the Golsovia River drainage: 2 bears by State Registration Permit. Season Aug 1 – May 31

22A Remainder, 22B, 22D, 22E: 2 bears by State Registration Permit. Season Aug 1 – June 30

22C: 1 bear by State Registration Permit. Season Aug 1 – June 30

**3: Why should this regulation change be made?**

Consistence is needed between the state subsistence brown bear RB699 permit and the federal regulations for brown bear hunting in Unit 22.

**4: What, if any, impact will this change have on the wildlife population impacted by the proposed regulatory change?**

None. Little to no harvest occurs under the RB699 state registration permit for brown bear in Unit 22.

**5: How will this change affect federal subsistence uses?**

The regulations will be easier to read and understand and will be consistent between state and federal regulations.

**6: How will this change affect other uses, such as state subsistence/personal use, sport/recreational and commercial uses?**

Same as #5 – consistency between state and federal regulations will make them easier to understand.
