Taku River Federal Subsistence Salmon Fishery regulations announced

JUNEAU, Alaska, June 16, 2025 – The Taku River federal subsistence Sockeye Salmon season is designated to be July 15 – Aug. 14, by Juneau District Ranger Michael Downs, under authority delegated by the Federal Subsistence Board.

The decision was made after input was gathered at a public hearing on May 12, and in consultation with the Pacific Salmon Commission. The Taku River is a transboundary river system subject to the Pacific Salmon Treaty.
