Background to assist: Government investigations confirmed law enforcement is involved in this illegal scheme that started on or about January 1, 2016, and continues today, August 10, 2025. In this case, information was redacted and could not be provided through that avenue due to legal restrictions. The FOIA/P request in processing will provide the redacted law enforcement activity - police, fire, ems etc. The scam can then be unfolded and the correct authorities notified. It is unclear how the law enforcement activity is directly or indirectly tied to the activities targeting me. There is also an unknown privately funded aspect tied to the law enforcement activity. To provide minimum key details the activities and programs consist of harassment and stalking by thousands of participants, companies, and aircraft 24 hours a day, seven days a week. This activity appears to be related to multi-layer fraud and a public safety program scam that may involve an authority, police department, fire department, contractor, tenant, vendor, operator, flight school, supplier, or potentially an international agreement. I have never taken part in any contract involving airports or that would support a law enforcement activity. There is no consent, no valid employment contract, no employer, and no application. No law enforcement, authority, agency, or country has consent. I was terminated by my last employer on February 9, 2016, after reporting malicious harassment and stalking. I stopped operating a motor vehicle in October of 2017 due to life and death safety concerns caused by the large number of individuals engaging in illegal activities targeting me which continue to this day. I have been a victim for going on 10 years. This illegal scam could also be related to terrorism, identity theft for the purpose of ghost employee and government fraud.</p> <p>The information on this activity may be found with the Chesapeake & Ohio Canal National Historical Park Commission which advises the U.S. Secretary of the Interior on Park related matters.</p> <p>The commission includes appointed members by the Secretary of the Interior with recommendations from various stakeholders including governors and local authorities. The local authority's part is somewhat concerning to the situation due to the unknown law enforcement activity. DOI-2025-008842	Bogardus, Kevin	E&E News	<p>I request the finalized review of agency positions to be placed in Schedule Policy/Career, otherwise known as Schedule F, conducted by the Department of the Interior.</p> <p>I also request any petitions submitted on a rolling basis by DOI to the Office of Personnel Management to place agency positions in Schedule Policy/Career, otherwise known as Schedule F, from Jan. 20 to Aug. 18, 2025.</p> <p>This finalized review was to be conducted within 120 days of DOI's preliminary review, which was due April 20, 2025, so no later than August 18, 2025, according to OPM guidance titled "Guidance on Implementing President Trump's Executive Order titled, 'Restoring Accountability To Policy-Influencing Positions Within the Federal Workforce,'" dated Jan. 27, 2025 (please see https://chcoc.gov/sites/default/files/OPM%20Memorandum%20re%20Schedule%20Policy%20Career%20Guidance%20FINAL.pdf).</p> <p>This finalized review and these petitions submitted on a rolling basis are described in the following excerpt of that guidance:</p> <p>"Executive Order 13957, as amended, directs each agency head to review positions within his or her agency and identify those appropriately categorized as policy-influencing. Agency heads will then petition OPM to recommend that the President place those positions in Schedule Policy/Career. A new executive order will subsequently effectuate the transfers into Schedule Policy/Career.
