Customary and Traditional Use Determination–Salmon

KODIAK AREA

Explain why this regulation change should be made

The Kodiak Station CDP should be used instead of the Kodiak Coast Guard Base in the Customary and Traditional Use Determination to harvest salmon in the Kodiak Area except the Mainland District as there

is USCG military housing off-base including those in Nemitz, Lake Louise, and Aviation Hill. This is appropriate to include this designation to encompass the intent of the original formation of this customary and traditional use determination regulation more effectively, for harvesting salmon in the Kodiak Area except in the mainland district. The residents that reside in the Kodiak National Wildlife Refuge facilities will be exempt from the Kodiak Station Census-Designated Place exemption. This language was proposed at the Fall 2025 Kodiak/Aleutians Regional Advisory Council meeting in recognizing customary and traditional uses of Kodiak for Unit 8 brown bear (WP26-32: Unit 8 brown bear; recognize customary and traditional uses of Kodiak) and should be adopted for salmon.
