General Description:

This proposal seeks to mirror Afognak Bay federal subsistence regulations to limit methods and means to rod and reel upstream of the regulatory markers.

Proposed Regulation:

CFR____.27(e)(9) Kodiak Area
(iii) You may subsistence fish for salmon with rod and reel only in the following locations
(D) In the Northeast Arm of Kazakof Bay (Danger Bay) north and east of a line bound by a point on the west shore at 58° 12.55' N. lat., 152° 34.30' W. long., and a point on the east shore at 58° 12.47' N. lat., 152° 33.93' W. long.

A description of the regulatory change(s) desired;

This proposal seeks to mirror Afognak Bay federal subsistence regulations to limit methods and means to only rod and reel upstream of the regulatory markers established in the State subsistence fishery in Danger Bay/Kazakof Bay.

A statement explaining why each change is necessary;

It was my understanding that the federal regulations would be changed to mirror State subsistence regulations, but it did not change since the Board of Fisheries adopted the changes to the State subsistence fishery.

I want to preserve these runs for future generations and move the gillnets and beach seines away from the creek mouths but still let people use rod and reel above the markers. Since it's harder to catch large amounts of fish with rod and reel, there's not as much chance to harm the run as beach seines and gillnets being used in the creeks.
