Unit 19A Moose Permit Distribution

EXPLANATION: This Emergency Special Action is to establish the number of moose permits for qualified residents for hunting on federal public lands in Unit 19A for qualifying residents.

REGULATION: 36 CFR 242.26(n)(19) and 43 CFR 51.26(n)(19) are amended to add:

Unit 19A – Moose

*1 antlered bull by Federal drawing permit or a State permit. Federal Sep. 1 - Sep. 20
public lands are closed to the taking of moose except by residents of
Tuluksak, Lower Kalskag, Upper Kalskag, Aniak, Chuathbaluk, and
Crooked Creek hunting under these regulations.*

100 draw permits will be issued with the following allocation:

Tuluksak - 19

Lower Tuluksak - 20

Upper Kalskag - 15

Aniak - 34

Chuathbaluk - 7

Crooked Creek – 5

***Any permits left over from each village after scheduled distribution
may be distributed to other qualified residents.***

JUSTIFICATION: A limit of 100 Federal permits have been issued in 19A for over 15 years and the population has continued to grow. The allocation of permits for each village is based on the 2020 census data. With an increased population and not having issued all permits in recent years, there is little concern on the potential for overharvest, and subsistence opportunity is being provided for.
