## Federal Subsistence Board to Hold Work Session in Anchorage, August 2-3, 2023

Correction: This announcement has been corrected to clarify that the purpose of the Federal Subsistence Board executive session is to develop recommendations to the Secretaries of Interior and Agriculture for appointments to the Regional Advisory Councils.

The Federal Subsistence Board (Board) will hold a work session August 2-3, 2023, beginning at 9:00 a.m. daily until the Board has completed its work. The work session will be held in the Gordon Watson Conference Room of the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service Regional Office in Anchorage, at 1011 E. Tudor Road.

During the work session, the Board will review the Regional Advisory Council (Councils) FY22 annual report replies and the Councils' charter change requests and receive briefings on the Regional Advisory Council Correspondence Policy and the Southeast Council letter to the Board on transboundary river watersheds. The Board may also discuss other business items.

The public is invited to participate in this work session via teleconference. To participate, dial toll-free (888)-244-7761 (passcode 4622241). The full agenda and meeting materials will be available online prior to the meeting at www.doi.gov/subsistence/board.

The Board will also hold an executive session on Thursday, August 3, 2023. This meeting will be closed to the public. The purpose of the meeting is to develop recommendations to the Secretaries of Interior and Agriculture for appointments to the Regional Advisory Councils. A summary of the executive session will be made available to the Councils and, upon request, to the public.
