Cost Share with Alaska Department of Fish and Game

Forest

Service

The Chugach National Forest Subsistence Program is continuing to support wildlife surveys for moose, caribou, and mountain goats in Units 6 and 7 through a cost share agreement with ADFG. This continues ongoing cooperative monitoring projects.

Prince William Sound Zone

Moose 6C

The 2022 Season opened September 1.

Approximately 764 applications received for 60 moose permits

Bull moose season concluded on October 31st with 25 out of 30 bulls harvested.

Cow moose season concluded on December 31st with 29 out of 30 antlerless moose harvested.

The Forest Service received 878 applications for the 2023 Unit 6C moose drawing.

Alaska Department of Fish and Game (ADFG) conducted aerial composition surveys for moose in unit 6C in early December 2022 using funds from the Chugach National Forest. A total of 240 moose were observed. Twenty of these moose were bulls, 189 were cows, and 31 were calves. Using these numbers, 11 Bulls: 100 Cows (B:C) and 16 calves: 100 Cows (c:C) were observed. Statistical analysis found a bull to cow ratio of 1:14 and a calf to cow ratio of 5:33 at a 90% Confidence Interval. Earlier than predicted antler casting may have affected the quality of this survey data for the bull to cow estimate. (ADF&G 2023)





Sitka Black-tailed Deer

Sitka Black-tailed deer season concluded on January 31st, 2023. No harvest data is currently available.

Mountain Goat

The Mountain Goat season for unit 6D concludes on February 28th, 2023.

Salmon

71 permits were issued for the Prince William Sound area freshwater fishery. Currently, there is poor harvest report returns and a reminder letter has been sent to subsistence users. Thus far 93 Coho and 70 Sockeye have been reported harvested under this fishery.

Kenai Peninsula Zone

Caribou

The Unit 7 Caribou season concluded on December 31st, 2022. One caribou was harvested this season with a total of 74 permits issued.

Mountain Goat

The Unit 7 subsistence Mountain Goat season concluded on November 14th, 2022. Three drawing permits were issued, one Mountain Goat was harvested.
