On behalf of the Secretary of the Interior, AVSO supports the Secretary's public trust responsibilities for valuation needs related to realty actions by four U.S. Department of the Interior agencies (Bureau of Land Management, Bureau of Reclamation, U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, and National Park Service). The supported realty actions include acquisitions, disposals, leases, rights-of-way, and rentals between non-Federal entities and the Federal Government across all 50 states.


