Summary

The Biden Administration's Executive Orders to advance DEIA in the Federal Workforce provide both opportunities and expectations for the federal government to create and retain a workforce that mirrors the public it serves. Despite this commitment, barriers to being a diverse, equitable, inclusive and accessible employer persist. How can DOI successfully identify and eliminate these impediments to DEIA? This presentation will provide an overview of some of the main resources currently in place that can aid workforce planning stakeholders in understanding workforce demographic trends and identifying the root causes behind barriers to workforce DEIA at the department. We will focus on the DEIA data visualization tools that are available to examine workforce demographic trends, and the EEOC's Management Directive (MD)-715 Model Equal Employment Opportunity Program Evaluation, and how these can be leveraged to successfully meet DEIA-related strategic goals.
