WORKING GROUP UPDATES

Studies

- Had a good meeting with Department experts regarding modeling.
- Team is also diving into whether there are other gaps, other things to look at.
- Still in the early stages, but hope to have solid information on which to report at the September meeting.

Non-Fossil

- Will add presenter to cover slide.
- Will add in slides to provide more background.
- Will change order of slides.
- One of the recommendations will need to be tweaked (OSCLA) to reflect that it is a recommendation for the Secretary to submit a request to Congress to consider change.
NOTE: Will need to change in front with the full committee so that everyone at the meeting is aware.
- The other three recommendations should take 15 minutes or so to present. Solar will likely generate the most discussion. Will loop back to provide sense of how much time for the discussion.

Offshore

- Don't anticipate that it will take a lot of time. This builds on what was approved at the last RPC meeting, with the goal to add specificity to make the process more transparent.
- Will provide data to support.

- Will present onshore recommendations one by one.
